- Protect at least 30% and strictly protect 10% EU's sea areas
- Restore 25.000 km free flowing rivers


MISSION CHARTER







SYNERGIES WITH OTHER EU FUNDS

EMFAF PROGRAMME

- **shared management**: national plans in preparation. 8 national programmes submitted until mid-November: CZ, FR, IT, CY, LT, AT, FI, SE. AT, and CZ explicitly refer to synergies with Mission Ocean (**estimated committed volume €60M**)
- **direct management** calls launched in 2022 on blue career and regional flagships in EU sea basins (indicative budget **EUR 15.1 million** in 2022) have been designed to complement activities implemented by Mission Ocean and Waters in its WP 2021 and 2022.

Recovery and Resilience Fund

The investments of coastal MSs, in particular Belgium, Cyprus, Greece, France, Italy, Poland, Portugal and Spain in blue sectors and marine domains amount to **EUR 10.7 billion** (around 1.5% of the total RRF budget)





SYNERGIES WITH OTHER EU FUNDS



BlueInvest: Innovation projects led by SMEs (start-up or scale-up) related to the mission can benefit from: Technical Assistance for Investment Readiness from the BlueInvest platform, and are eligible for funding under InvestEU (€ 500 million from InvestEU/EIB/EMFAF, which is expected to mobilise around 1 bn of additional private funding, under 'InvestEU Blue Economy')






EXAMPLE ADRION: Adriatic Ionian Interreg

The project launched calls for proposal through which <u>5 projects</u> have been selected, also with WB partners, thus contributing directly to the Widening objectives:

- 1 project under the topic blue economy
- 2 projects under the topic circular economy
- 1 project under the topic social Innovation
- 1 project under the topic renewable energy

17 projects received- 5 projects selected
